Purchase your hand(s) in advance online at www.HeadForTheHillsWV.com or onsite during the Festival Friday-Saturday, Sept 3-4, 2021 at the Legendary Pennsboro Speedway, Pennsboro, WV.

Day one, check in Friday, Sept. 3, beginning at 8:15 am. Day two, check in Saturday, Sept 4, at 8 am. Sign in to collect your passport and tour map! Double 8 Shuffle & Deal takes place Saturday, Sept. 4, 2021, from Noon-6 pm for **ALL Day One and Day Two Double 8 Poker Tour participants.**

Kickstands up Friday, Sept. 3, at 9:15 am and Saturday, Sept. 4, at 8:30 am. Participants choosing to complete the poker tour in four-wheeled vehicles will leave immediately behind motorcycles for rider safety! Last bike in at 2 pm Friday, Sept. 3, and last bike in at 1:30 pm Saturday, Sept. 4. This run will take about 5 hours to complete, allowing 5-10 minutes at each stop.

Don't forget to have your passport stamped at each stop. The first 10 stamps, in any order, earn you a full hand of five cards. Each stamp after the first 10 earns you one discard. Stop at all 15 locations and earn both your hand of five cards and five discards. *(No double stamps! All locations have a unique stamp!)* Once a card is discarded from your hand, that card is no longer valid and cannot be used in your final hand of five cards.

Receive your playing cards when you turn in your stamped passport during the Double 8 Poker Tour Shuffle & Deal Saturday, Sept. 4, from Noon-6 pm.

Just as in the game of poker, the best hand wins! **NO WILD CARDS!** Fifth-first place winners will be announced Saturday, Sept. 5, at 9:15 pm during Head for the Hills Festival entertainment. Participants must be present in the event a tie-breaker deal is needed. Should multiple players tie, those players will be dealt a new hand of five *(no discards/no wild cards)* until the best hand wins.

Some Poker Tour stops are located within our small towns, while others are out in the hills! Adventure, fun and a chance to ride with old friends and new are all part of the Double 8 Poker Tour experience! Good Luck!!

Double 8 Poker Tour Scoring

Hands from Highest to Lowest

1. Royal flush: A, K, Q, J, 10, all the same suit.



2. Straight flush: Five cards in sequence, all the same suit.



3. Four of a kind: All four cards of the same rank.



4. Full house: Three of a kind with a pair.



5. Flush: Any five cards of the same suit, but not in sequence.



6. Straight: Five cards in sequence, but not the same suit.



7. Three of a kind: Three cards of the same rank.



8. Two pair: Two different pairs.



9. Pair: Two cards of the same rank.



10. High Card: Highest card wins. For example, in the hand below, the jack is the highest card.
