

## 2023 Double 8 Poker Tour

## ALL road legal vehicles welcome! TWO INDIVIDUAL CONTESTS

Brand NEW this year, our Double 8 Poker Tour features two individual contests. The first Friday, Sept. 15, and the second Saturday, Sept. 16. Ante Up Per Person - $\mathbf{\$ 2 0 . 0 0}$ per hand. Two hand maximum. Purchase entries in advance at www.HeadForTheHillsWV.com or onsite at the admission's trailer Thursday-Saturday, Sept. 14-16, 2023, just outside festival entry gate at the Legendary Pennsboro Speedway to register for your game card and tour map. Online entries must also register at the admission's trailer to pick up game card and tour map.

Friday's (Sept.15) game is Five Card Draw with no wild cards. The route consists of 7 stops at which players must collect a stamp on their game card. Players earn one card for each stamp. Players have the chance to earn two extra cards, if they collect stamps at all 7 stops. During game play, players will be dealt five cards up. Players will then have only one chance to discard up to two cards, depending on the number of stamps they collected. For example: if a player stopped at all 7 stops, they will have one opportunity to discard up to two cards and receive the corresponding number of new cards. Discards are no longer in play and are no longer valid. Best hand earns the win of a $\$ 250$ prize while worst hand will grab \$100! Shuffle \& Deal game play will be Friday, Sept. 15, from 4-6 pm at Margie's Bar \& Grill, 784 W. Myles Ave., Pennsboro. Winners will be announced Friday evening during festival entertainment. Stops will be stamping game cards Friday, Sept. 15, from $11 \mathrm{am}-4 \mathrm{pm}$.

Saturday's (Sept. 16) game is Seven Card Draw with no wild cards. The route consists of 10 stops at which players must collect a stamp on their game card. Players earn one card for each stamp. Players have the chance to earn three extra cards, if they collect stamps at all 10 stops. During game play, players will be dealt seven cards up. Players will then have only one chance to discard up to three cards, depending on the number of stamps they collected. For example: if a player stopped at all 10 stops, they will have one opportunity to discard up to three cards and receive the corresponding number of new cards. Players select the five best cards minus discards for their final hand. Only five cards can be played as your final hand. Discards are no longer in play and are no longer valid. Best hand for this contest will win $\$ 500$ while the worst hand grabs $\$ 250$. Shuffle \& Deal game play will be Saturday afternoon, Sept. 16, from $2-4$ pm at Margie's Bar \& Grill, 784 West Myles Avenue, Pennsboro. Winners will be announced Saturday evening during festival entertainment. Stops will be stamping game cards Saturday, Sept. 16 from $8 \mathrm{am}-2 \mathrm{pm}$.

Just as in past years, stop by each of the locations on the poker tour route and check in to receive a stamp on your game card! Each individual stop earns you one card. NO WILD CARDS! Participants need not be present to win but in the event a tie-breaker deal is needed, participants not present must accept they will be represented by a stand in for the tiebreaker deal. Should multiple players tie, those players will be dealt a new hand of five (no discards/no wild cards) until the best hand wins. Participants may choose to follow the suggested route or map out their own route. Participants are not required to visit poker tour stops in any specific order. (No double stamps! All locations have a unique stamp!)

Some Poker Tour stops are located within our small towns, while others are out in the hills! Adventure, fun and a chance to ride with old friends and new are all part of the Double 8 Poker Tour experience! Good Luck!!

## 2023 Double 8 Poker Tour Scoring

## Hands from Highest to Lowest ~ Suit Strength: Spades, Hearts, Diamonds, Clubs

1. Royal flush: A, K, Q, J, 10, all the same suit.

2. Straight flush: 5 cards in sequence, all same suit.

3. Four of a kind: All four cards of the same rank.

4. Full house: Three of a kind with a pair.

5. Flush: Any five cards of the same suit, but not in sequence.

6. Straight: Five cards in sequence, but not the same suit.
